
that Washington College is participating for the fifth year in the Tax Counseling Project, (TCP), a project of the Center for Law and Human Services, which seeks and trains volunteers to prepare free of charge Federal and State Income Tax Returns for low income families in Illinois; and

that the College has been designated by TCP as its training center for the City of Chicago, hosting more than 20 sessions of training for both manual and electronic filing during the month of January; and

that beginning on January 24, 2000, volunteers will begin the tax filing process that has benefited thousands of clients during the past five years, many of them being staff and students of the College; and

that Washington College is pleased to participate in this important endeavor this year by providing space and computer resources to TCP and hopes to increase the benefits provided to Chicagoland taxpayers last year, when, 952 clients were served who received a total of \$1,272,291.00 in federal refunds.
