that in Board Report 21219 dated April 14, 1999 the Board authorized technical support services from Oracle Corporation to assist CCC with the Oracle Government Financial (OGF)-Financial Management System (FMS) software applications and Oracle databases; and

that Oracle has proposed to provide the necessary software updates and maintenance services from July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001, at a total cost of \$217,239.50; and this proposal has been reviewed and is recommended by OIT staff; and

WAIVER OF COMPETITIVE PROCEDURE REQUIREMENT

Each of Axiom, Oracle, Project Leadership Associates, and Verio is uniquely qualified to perform the abovementioned services, and has previously provided such services to CCC.
