that on May 12, 2000, Malcolm X College hosted its Annual Principal's Breakfast and Seniors Day Program for high school seniors throughout the Chicago area. Over 300 students representing eight (8) high schools and three (3) community based organizations were in attendance. Students attended workshops on college survival skills, financial aid, careers in health, business and technology;

that over 27 Chicago Public Schools' principals and their staff attended (9 principals and 18 administrative staff) representing 21 high schools (Westinghouse, Curie, Whitney Young, Collins, Austin, Marshall, Near North, Simpson, Crane, Dunbar, Best Practice, Roosevelt, Sullivan, Orr, Hyde Park, Flowers, Farragut, SouthSide, College Prep, South Shore, Tilden, and Jones Academy) were in attendance; and

that five schools received the Malcolm X College Passport Award in recognition for being our top feeder schools (Westinghouse, Crane, Marshall, Austin and Collins).
