REPORTS

that Elena Mulcahy, Director of School/College Partnerships at Truman College, ran a successful College Day April 7 for students from Senn High School; and

that all the Senn students who visited the College said they enjoyed the visit with 85 percent saying they would consider enrolling at Truman College after high school; and

that the event, billed under the heading "continuing your education doesn't have to be scary or cost a lot of money," offered students a chance to sample College level classes and meet Truman's professors; and

that also in the spring, President, Phoebe Helm was Principal for a Day and the graduation speaker at Senn Metro Academy, one of Truman College's "feeder" high schools; and

that Dr. Mulcahy was Principal for a Day at Stockton Elementary School where she talked to students, visited classrooms, met teachers, toured Stockton's preschool and made connections that may benefit Truman College's Early Childhood Education Program; and

that other activities carried out by the Office of School/College Partnerships included a visit to Truman by 20 Students from Rodolfo Lozano Bilingual and International Center and a portfolio workshop for 35 local high school teachers, Truman College adult educators and Truman faculty; and

that the portfolio workshop, led by Adult Educator Christine Aguila, was designed to show teachers how to create academic portfolios and teach the techniques to their students.
