REPORTS

that on May 20th Washington College held graduation ceremonies at the Chicago Theater conferring diplomas and certificates to those students who have pursued their studies on campus and marking the first graduating class of the British Partnership; and

that President Nancy DeSombre of Washington College, the Deputy Lord Mayor of Birmingham and President/Principal Patricia Morgan-Webb of New College Nottingham jointly conferred the first International Associate Degrees to the first graduating class of eighteen students who have completed the program since its inception in 1998; and

that the International Associates Degree Program, a world first, provides the opportunity for students at several UK Colleges to earn a US Associate Degree through Washington College; and

that the graduation ceremony was attended by Trustee Rev. Ferdinand Hargrett and Vice Chancellor Deidra Lewis, who had the task of presenting our graduation medallions; and

that during the graduation ceremony 187 students in the US Armed Forces who have earned their degrees through programs for the military were also recognized.
