that on June 2, 365 certificates were awarded to students in career training programs, prepared to work in the fields of business, computers, allied health, applied technology and human services. Classes were offered at Wright's Center for Lifelong Learning and the Vocational Education Center at Humboldt Park.

This brings the total number of career training graduates to 600 for the year, 2000. In February, 235 were graduated.

ADULT LEARNING SKILLS PROGRAM

that on June 10, 343 adult learning students completed the highest levels on Wright College's Adult Learning Skills Program (ALSP). There were 250 GED graduates and 94 ESL graduates. They were honored at a dinner dance on the evening before graduation.

that 5 members of the ALSP staff donated time and service at the "Minds Meet 2000 Scholarship Competition" for high school students. Alderperson Dorothy Tillman, Tobacco Road, Inc., WGCI AM/FM and V-103 sponsored the event, which took place on Sunday, May 28 at the University of Illinois at Chicago Pavilion.

About 8,000 high school students attended the event as four teams of 5 students each competed for their share of a \$5,000 scholarship.
