**PROJECT P.R.I.D.E.**

that the Business and Industry Services Division of Malcolm X College in partnership with UBM, Inc., St. Paul Church of God in Christ, the Illinois Department of Employment Security, The Chicago Park District and Mayor's Office of Workforce Development designed a 10 week Direct Instruction and Life Skills Program that will prepare 25 individuals for entry into construction and/or craft-trades jobs; and that UBM, Inc., provided the college with a \$10,000 grant to support the project along with a commitment to hire completers.

**UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO HOSPITALS**

that effective as of March 1, 2000, health care professionals interested in employment as a Surgical Technologist must sit for and successfully pass the National Certifying Examination for Surgical Technologist; and that 21 hospital employees successfully completed training on March 22 and now qualify to sit for the examination.

**AMERITECH**

that the Business and Industry Services in partnership with New Galilee M.B. Church Advocacy & Technology Center designed a 10 week program to deliver basic computer literacy and repair training to community residents through facilities located at the church; and that Ameritech provided the college with a \$25,000 donation to support training for up to 25 community residents.

**COOK COUNTY HOSPITAL**

that 39 employees successfully completed training in April, 2000 and were presented with certificates of completion from Malcolm X College.
