
that the bus tour covered three Southern states and focused on historically African American Colleges and universities, including:

- > Dillard University
- > Jackson State University
- > Philander Smith College
- > Tougaloo College
- > University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff
- > Xavier University of Louisiana

that the idea behind the tour was to expose students to educational opportunities outside Illinois, especially historically African American colleges providing a smaller teacher-to-student ratio and a cultural support system designed to help African American students succeed; and

that three Truman College students have already applied to several of the colleges visited.
