that on Thursday, April 13, 2000, Washington College celebrated its third annual Business Professional of the Year Luncheon honoring Norman Bobbins, CEO of LaSalle Bank, in recognition of his commitment to the Chicago Business world and to the partnership between business and education; and

that Mr. Bobbins, who is the current chair of the Chicagoland Chamber of Commerce, was recently appointed by Mayor Daley as Commissioner of the Public Building Commission. Mr. Bobbins was also appointed by Governor Ryan to the Governor's Commission on the Status of Women in Illinois.
