RENEWAL AGREEMENT AND SOCIAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH
SCHOLARSHIP AND GUIDANCE ASSOCIATION
AND
TRUMAN MIDDLE COLLEGE

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that the Illinois State Board of Education has notified the City Colleges of Chicago ("CCC") that a renewal application for FY00 funding in the amount of \$2,406,512 was approved for the Truants' Alternative and Optional Education Program (TAOEP), to continue providing an extensive delivery of alternative and optional education programs and services to retrieved high school dropouts 16 to 21 years of age through the CCC Alternative Education Consortium which includes the Truman Middle College located at Truman College; and

that of the \$1,356,467 allocated for CCC programs, \$404,405 was budgeted for Truman Middle College; and an integral component for the Truman Middle College model is the clinical counseling achieving dual goals of counseling at-risk students individually and in groups, and training/consulting with faculty and the principal of the school; and

that the Scholarship and Guidance Association has provided this component to the Truman Middle College since its inception in 1986 and will provide for FY00 a 3/4 time clinical social worker who will provide services 4 days per week, train faculty and staff and consultant services in the amount of \$18,700; and


that Truman College has negotiated additional Agreement with the Scholarship and Guidance Association to provide for a full-time social worker/case manager to provide counseling and associated support services to ten (10) Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) wards and their parents, guardians and/or foster parents, including support services to DCFS instructors, coordination of educational services, and consultation to the principal of Truman Middle College in the amount of \$11,272.00. All services of the Scholarship and Guidance Association will occur at Truman Middle College during from March 1, 2000 through June 30, 2000.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approve the execution of the Agreements with the Scholarship and Guidance Association, subject to the specific restrictions and limitations set forth by the Illinois State Board of Education for the period March 1, 2000 through June 30, 2000, and authorize the Vice Chairman and the Assistant Secretary to execute the Agreements on behalf of the Board.
