that Congresswoman Jan Schakowsky of the 9th District (D-IL) conducted an open forum on Census 2000 for students at Truman College on February 22, 2000; and


that the Congresswoman emphasized the importance of a complete Census count of all Chicago residents; and

that Truman College recognizes the need to educate the community about the Census, the importance of all residents' inclusion in the national count, how the Census effects the funding for education, urban infrastructure, housing and social services, and that the Census determines political boundaries and the number of representatives Illinois residents will have in Washington, D.C. and in Springfield; and

that Truman College will host the first Language Day kick-off for Census 2000, to introduce students and the community to the language translation services available at Truman to help individuals complete their Census forms; and

that Congresswoman Schakowsky and representatives from the Chicago Census Bureau will be available to answer questions at both events.
