
REPORTS that as of end of fall 1999, headcount enrollment in continuing education and special interest in all subterms reached 25,692 students. End-of-Term enrollment is presented for continuing education and special interest courses because they start at different times during the term and are not captured in the traditional census date statistics.

Headcount enrollment in continuing education, subterms A and B, reached 6,272 students at the end of fall 1999. FTE enrollment reached 1,133 students.

A total of 19,420 students were enrolled in special interest courses, subterms C and D, by the end of fall 1999. FTE enrollments for special interest courses are not reported because they do not have a credit hour value.
