OPENING ENROLLMENT REPORT: Spring 2000

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS that as of Census Date, unduplicated headcount enrollment in all programs reached 75,233 students, and the Full-Time-Equivalent (FTE) enrollment reached 37,613 FTE students (Tables 1 and 2). Opening spring enrollment figures represent a *snapshot of enrollments* as of Census Date (February 15, 2000) and do not include registrations that will take place in several programs during the spring term. State and federal government agencies use census date information to report educational statistics.

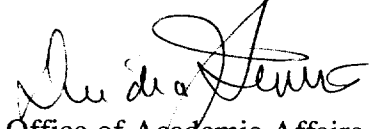
A total of 64,279 headcount students and 36,747 FTE students were reported to the Illinois Community College Board. ICCB figures do not include Special Interest or Military enrollments because they are not reimbursed by the state.

Headcount enrollment in the credit program reached 29,604 students, a decrease of 1.3 percent over the previous year. The credit FTE enrollment reached 17,011 FTE students, which represents a 0.5 percent decrease over the previous year.

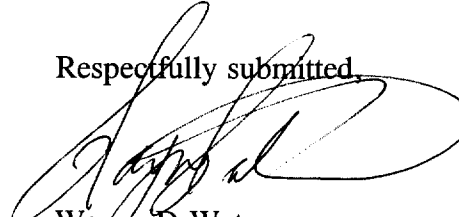
Headcount enrollment in college credit, pre-credit, and vocational skills reached 33,032 students, a decrease of 1.4 percent compared to spring 1999 (Table 1 and Figure 1). These programs represent the traditional baccalaureate/transfer, occupational and remedial courses in the district. FTE enrollment reached 18,880 students, a decrease of 1.1 percent (Table 2 and Figure 1).

Headcount enrollment in the ALSP program reached 30,188 students, a decrease of 0.3 percent compared to spring 1999 (Tables 1 and 3; Figure 3). FTE enrollment reached 17,161 FTE students, a decrease of 4.1 percent (Tables 2 and 3; Figure 3).

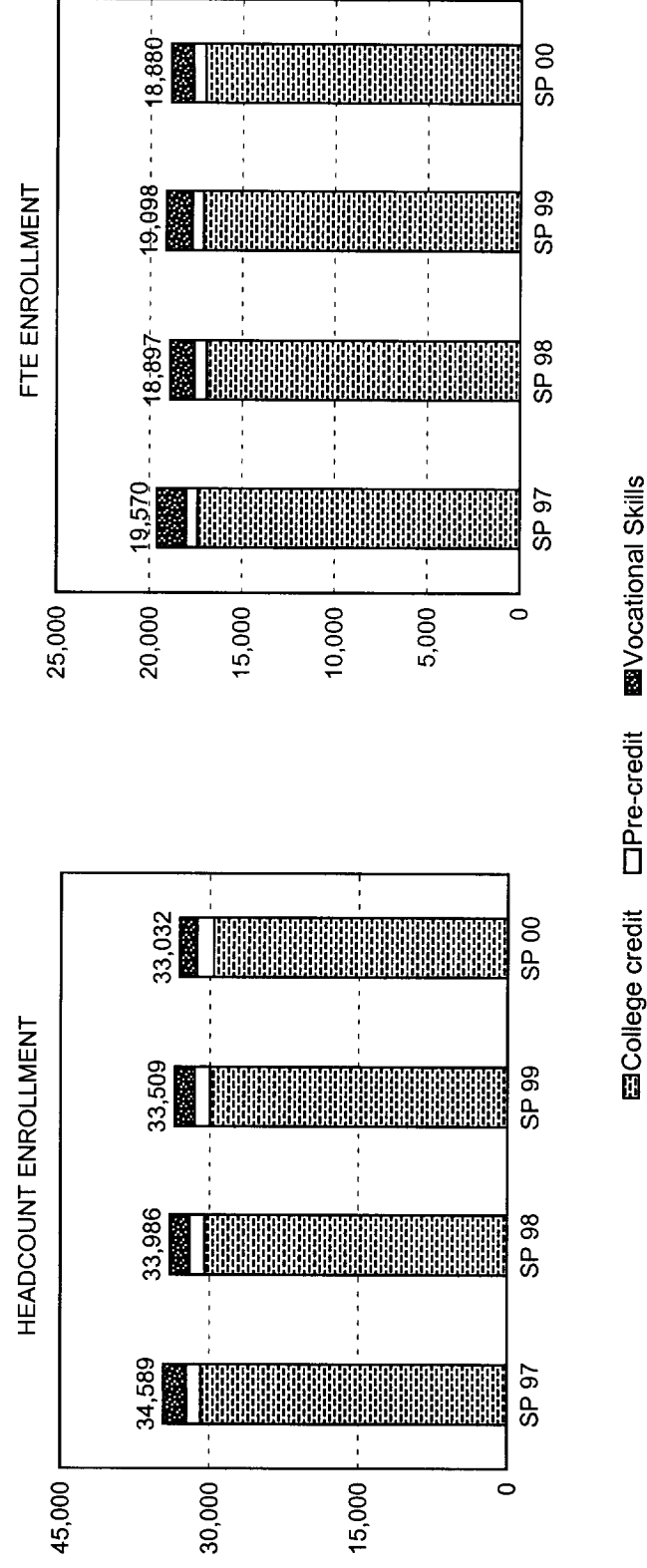

 SPRING 1997-2000

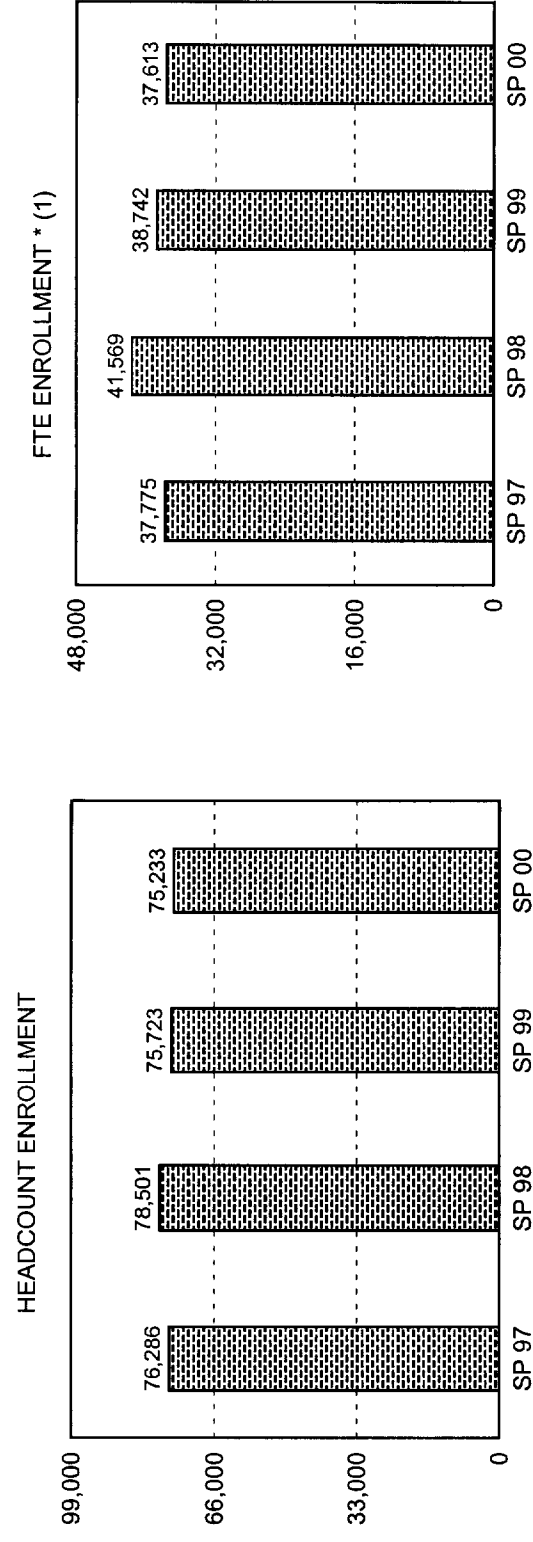

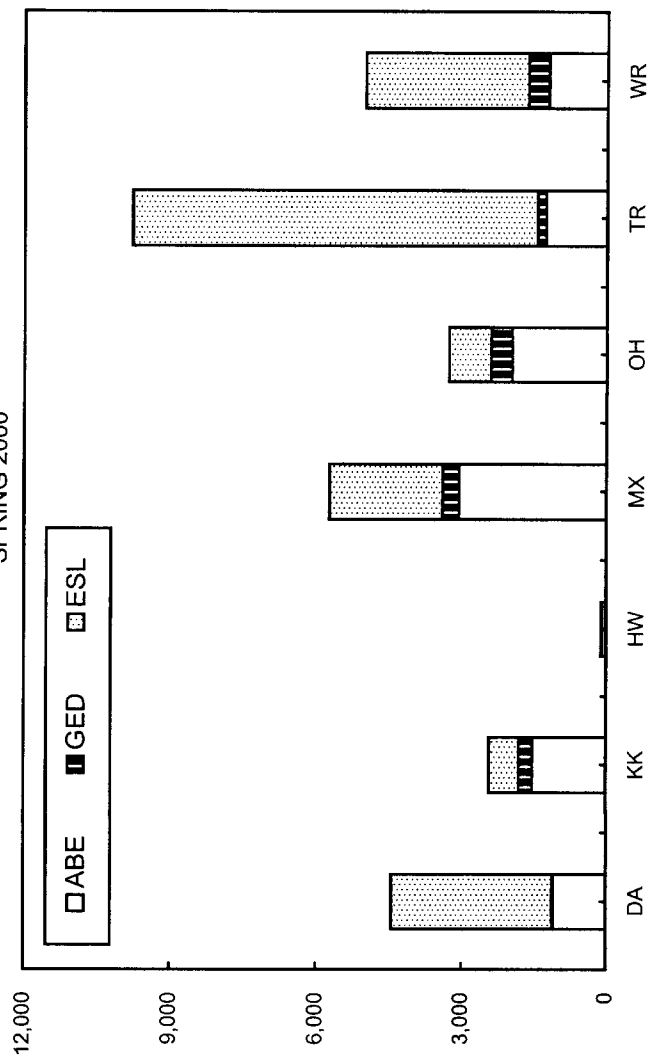
