
that the National Council of Instructional Administrators makes awards each year to community colleges across the nation for outstanding programs and other initiatives; and

that in 1999, Daley College received an "Exemplary Initiatives in the Classroom" award for the Keystone Project, an innovative approach to teaching mathematics to remedial students developed by Dr. Vali Siadat, Professor of Mathematics and Dr. Yoram Sagher, Professor of Mathematics at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and that this led to publication and dissemination of this project to educators throughout the nation and to publication of an article on this project as the lead article in Teaching for Success, the largest faculty development publication in the nation; and

that Daley College has been notified that for 2000, it will be receiving an "Honorary Mention in Enhancing Student Learning" for its Amigos Project, an innovative approach to teaching English and Spanish that promotes intercultural understanding developed by Todd Lakin, an instructor in Spanish; and

that the award will be accepted by Dr. Mark Warden, Interim President of Daley College at the annual meeting of the Association of American Community Colleges in Washington, D.C. Was accepted in April.
