OPENING ENROLLMENT REPORT: FALL 2000

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS that as of Census Date, unduplicated headcount enrollment in all programs reached 76,859 students, and the Full-Time-Equivalent (FTE) enrollment reached 37,610 FTE students (Tables 1 and 2). Opening fall enrollment figures represent a *snapshot of enrollments* as of Census Date (September 30, 2000) and do not include registrations that will take place in several programs during the fall term. State and federal government agencies use census date information to report educational statistics.


A total of 66,396 headcount students and 36,768 FTE students were reported to the Illinois Community College Board. ICCB figures do not include Special Interest or Military enrollments because they are not reimbursed by the state.

Headcount enrollment in the credit program reached 30,332 students, a decrease of 2.9 percent over the previous year. The credit FTE enrollment reached 17,156 FTE students, which represents one percent decrease over the previous year.

Headcount enrollment in college credit, pre-credit, and vocational skills reached 34,351 students, a decrease of three percent compared to fall 1999 (Table 1 and Figure 1). These programs represent the traditional baccalaureate/transfer, occupational and remedial courses in the district. FTE enrollment reached 18,872 students, a decrease of 1.7 percent (Table 2 and Figure 1).

Headcount enrollment in the adult education program reached 30,819 students, an increase of 1.6 percent compared to fall 1999 (Tables 1 and 3; Figure 3). FTE enrollment reached 17,098 FTE students, a decrease of 3.1 percent (Tables 2 and 3; Figure 3).
