**PROGRAM AGREEMENT – CERTIFICATE OF PASTRY ARTS**

**REPORTS:** that the City Colleges of Chicago (“CCC”) desires to: (i) offer classes leading to a Certificate of Pastry Arts (“Certificate Program”); and (ii) provide continuing education classes in the baking and pastry arts ((i) and (ii) are collectively referred to herein as “Programs”); and

the internationally renowned French Pastry School (“FPS”) currently operates a baking and pastry arts training program and CCC desires to contract with FPS to design, provide and administer the Programs; and

FPS has developed a 24 week curriculum that will be offered a **minimum** of two and a **maximum** of four times per year. The tuition and fees will be \$13,477.00 per student; and

CCC will pay FPS a maximum of: (i) \$6500.00 per student for the first 32 students who successfully complete the Certificate Program; and (ii) \$3200.00 per student, for each additional student that successfully completes the Certificate Program; and (iii) 50% of the profits from all continuing education programs offered by FPS.


CCC will benefit from an anticipated first year profit of \$60,000 based on FPS previous year financial statement and from the association with two world reknowned pastry chefs who will help build and expand our programs and reputation.

**THEREFORE THE CHANCELLOR**

**RECOMMENDS:** that the Board of Trustees authorize the Chairman to negotiate and execute a three year agreement, with three additional one year extension options, with FPS.
