SUMMER REGISTRATION UP OVER LAST YEAR  
TRUMAN COLLEGE

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS that the Truman College Credit Program posted significant gains in summer enrollment over last year; and

that the total number of people (headcount) enrolling in summer classes this year was up 18 percent over summer 2000; and


that the number of Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) students, those taking at least 7.5 hours of credit, was up 20.6 percent this summer over the same date, June 23, last year; and

that the gains, which included 1,201 returning students, 528 students new to Credit, and 267 students new to City Colleges of Chicago, were attributed to the creation of new courses and programs as well as increased and innovative college-wide marketing and recruitment efforts; and

that the headcount enrollment in Adult Education programs was also up this summer, 3.6 percent over last summer; and

that the Continuing Education Department also posted gains, to date enrolling 1,835 students, a nearly 22 percent increase over the number of students enrolled at this time last year.
