THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that in Board Reports #'s 20915, 21103 and 21783 dated October 1, 1998, February 4, 1999, and February 3, 2000 respectively, the Board of Trustees awarded contracts to PSI Systems, Inc. for professional consulting services to provide OIT management and consulting services; and

that there is a continued need to retain the services of a professional technology consultant to provide OIT management and consulting services; for the period of February 2, 2001 through June 30, 2001 with an option to renew beginning July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002; and

that these services will include the following: Support the Student Administrative System (SPAS), Provide interface system support to the PeopleSoft HR and FMS Systems, change programs to accommodate FY2001/2002 ICCB changes, make required programming changes for FY2002 Financial Aid, including Pell, SEOG, ISAC and IVS, develop Hope Scholarship Processing, complete testing policy requirements, develop ISBE Adult Education processing for FY2001/2002 requirements for ICCB new processing, develop Workforce Investment Act and Clearinghouse processing for transfer students interfaces, modification to SPAS for: EPOS processing (Web and Voice registration), the Opportunities Program; IAI General Education courses, and the Student Services Center (One Stop), C Grade Policy, Modification to SPAS due to changes in Federal/State regulations and City Colleges of Chicago academic policy, Ongoing SPAS training, and any additional changes required by the City Colleges of Chicago; and

that PSI 's fees for these services will be in the amounts not to exceed \$510,000.00, including expenses for the period of February 2, 2001 through June 30, 2001; and

that this purchase of professional services is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

RECOMMENDS

THE CHANCELLOR

that the Board of Trustees authorize the issuance of a purchase order in the total amount of \$510,000.00, including expenses, to PSI Systems of Chicago, Illinois, from February 2, 2001 to June 30, 2001, and authorize the Chairman to execute any documents pertaining to these professional services on behalf of the Board.
