

that Kennedy-King College and the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University on behalf of Southern Illinois University Carbondale signed an articulation Agreement to provide a higher education baccalaureate degree program that builds on community college and university level learning experiences and eliminates duplication of instruction; and
