
REPORTS

that Daley College has participated in the National Internship Competition held by the U.S. Department of Energy for community colleges; in the summers of 1999 and 2000; Daley College received nine internships at the Argonne National Laboratory; and

that for the summer of 2001, Daley's faculty departments of Biological Sciences, Mathematics, Physical Sciences, and Computer Information Systems identified top achieving students and encouraged them to apply for this research experience; and that thirteen internships, six more than in previous years; and that Harold Myron, Director of Educational Programs at Argonne National Laboratory has confirmed that this is the highest number of internships to students at any one community college in the national program; and that the students offered internships are Sami Al-Nadi, Tania Becerna, Jakub Dobrzynski, Edward Gibson, Kelly Hamman, Teresa Haslinger, Xi Jiang, Ana Juarez, Maria Martinez, Leonardo Melo, Eric Outten, Dennis Peterson, and N'Kechia Wheat; and

that Daley College has been recognized as having the best record of student interns renewed by their departments to continue their research projects following the formal end of the program; and that students receiving these internships will receive a weekly stipend and housing allowance; and in the words of Dr. Myron, "will be working at the forefront of research, side-by-side and shoulder-to shoulder with top rated, internationally known research scientists" in such fields as biotechnology, human genetics, structural biology, environmental issues, and the Advanced Proton Source.
