TRUMAN COLLEGE


THE CHANCELLOR

that Ms. Walker taught electronics and physical science at Truman College for 15 years before taking on her current position, in which she created the college's Technology Learning Center, developed an Advanced Multimedia Training Program that evolved into the Web Design Certificate Program, helped establish the CISCO Academy program, and developed and maintains the college's Web site, which attracts more than 60,000 hits monthly from all over the world.
