that the family child care 20 week training program held its third completion ceremony on May 8, 2001. The 33 program completers now have the opportunity to start their own business as Family Child Care Providers or to work in a child care facility

that 25 percent of the students plan to obtain a CDA Certificate and 75 percent plan to pursue an Associate Applied Science degree at Malcolm X College

that based upon the retention rate of 95 percent, West Side Consortium Training Institute has committed to continue the program and plans are finalized to begin the next program in May 2001

that this 20 week training program was a result of a partnership and collaboration between Malcolm X College, Chicago Department of Human Services, Marcy Newberry Association, University of Illinois at Chicago, and the West Side Consortium




