
REPORTS that on April 27, 2001, Truman College hosted the City Colleges of Chicago Faculty and Library Internet Conference, during which educators from each of the City Colleges took part in workshops on Blackboard, Streaming Video, Virtual Reality and other cutting-edge computer applications; and

that on April 28, the college took part in the National CPR Weekend sponsored by the City Colleges of Chicago, training 166 people in cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and

that also on April 28, Truman College, in partnership with community based organizations, Congresswoman Jan Schakowsky and 46th Ward Alderman Helen Shiller, sponsored a registration drive to enable immigrants to file for legal permanent residency in the United States; and

that more than 500 people attended and 350 applications were processed by 45 volunteers from the college and the legislators' offices.
