that for the sixth consecutive year, Harold Washington College has partnered with The Center for Law and Human Services to provide equipment and space for free tax preparation for eligible low-income individuals and families, and


That The Tax Counseling Project has grown each year in terms of number of clients served, increased training sessions for volunteer tax preparations throughout the city, and increased staff support at Harold Washington College to provide this program, and

That over 600 volunteers were trained in five separate courses at Harold Washington College by The Center for Law and Human Services during January 2001, and Tax Counseling Project opened one of two electronic filing centers in the city at HWC on Saturday, January 27th, and will continue every Monday through Thursday evening and Saturdays until April 14th, and

That services provided by Harold Washington College included 22 computer workstations, 11 laser printers, photocopier, and client waiting area for this public service partnership.
