that 25 percent of the students plan to obtain a CDA Certificate and 60 percent plan to pursue an Associate In Applied Science degree at Malcolm X College, 15 percent will continue to work towards a GED

that based upon the retention rate of 98 percent, West Side Consortium Training Institute has committed to continue the program and plans are finalized to begin the next program in September 2001



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
RECOMMENDS
