

that Washington College adjunct Physical Science Lecturer, Mike Davis has gained notoriety for his work with Science Theatre Productions. Science Theatre Productions, which Mr. Davis founded, tours Chicago area schools performing a series of science demonstration shows aimed to educate and motivate students in the sciences, and

that as a result of his efforts he was recently featured on WBEZ's 848 Program as an 'International Man of Science.' He earned this title by performing science demonstrations for more than six months in Ireland. Mr. Davis has performed for more than 10,000 students in Ireland and more than 30,000 in the Chicago area. His 'signature' lab coat is covered with the autographs of students that have seen his show, and


that Mike Davis will appear on the new season of WPWR-TV's Emmy Award winning 'UP 'N RUNNING' as the host of the segment 'Adventures with Science Theater.' The first segment will air Sunday, October 28<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM, and

that in March of 2001, Mr. Davis was picked to perform for the Chicago City Science Fair at the Museum of Science and Industry, where he appeared on stage with Paul Vallas, ex-CEO of the Chicago Public Schools. The response was so favorable, he was asked to return for the 2002 Science Fair. When not performing for students, he provides teacher re-certification training to teachers in the Chicago Public Schools. He shows educators how to integrate dramatic science demonstrations into their traditional classes. He is also involved with numerous educational reform activities with other Washington College faculty.
