NEW GRANTS

Not In My House (PD# 020407)

Kennedy-King College has submitted a request to the Illinois Secretary of State's office for a grant of \$25,000 to be used to offer basic skills and GED preparation classes at domestic violence residential shelters. The period of performance for this project is from September 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003.

Workforce Investment Act Services (PD# 020405)

Kennedy-King College's Dawson Technical Institute collaborated with Youth Guidance of Chicago in the submission of a proposal to the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development in Chicago (MOWD) for \$59,000 to provide support classes for job preparation to students at Harper and Calumet High Schools. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003.

Learning Resource Center Information Infostructure Enhancement Grant Request (PD# 020406)

The District Office has submitted requests for the colleges to the Illinois Board of Higher Education under a special program titled, *NILRC: A Consortium of Community Colleges, Colleges and Universities*, for the purchase of new technology for the library or learning services department. The funds which have been requested, for technology enhancements include:

#### **Workforce Investment Act Services (PD# 020408)**

Kennedy-King College has collaborated with the Woodlawn Preservation and Investment Corp in the submission of a proposal to the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development in Chicago (MOWD) for \$72,000 to provide training to residents of Woodlawn and surrounding areas in construction, maintenance, CNA and basic computer literacy. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003.

#### **Telecommunications Network Cabling Installation Program (PD# 020409 - originally 01166)**

Wright College has received a grant from the Illinois Community Technology Fund for \$48,000 to train displaced, disadvantaged and/or underemployed workers to install telecommunications network cabling. The performance period for this project is from March 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

#### **GEAR UP / Youth on Youth Summer Academy (PD # 020410)**

Truman College has submitted proposals to the Seabury Foundation and to the Rice Foundation for \$26,760 to supplement Truman's GEAR UP funded project by providing a summer enrichment academy for Arai Middle School students. The project would be implemented during the summer of 2002.

#### **Wright College Core and Intensive Affiliate (PD# 020412)**

Wright College proposes to provide core and intensive services through the "One Stop" systems in Chicago. Wright has requested \$101,809 from the Mayors Office of Workforce Development in Chicago for a project which would provide recruitment, support, placement and job training. The performance period for the project is from July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003.

#### **Native American Youth Services (PD# 020413)**

Truman College's Institute for Native American Development has submitted a proposal to the WGN Radio *Neediest Kids Fund* for \$25,000 for a project to assist Native American youth in obtaining high school diplomas or GED certificates and matriculating into higher education, vocational training or the military. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003.

#### **Native American Heritage as Survival (PD# 020414)**

Truman College's Institute for Native American Development has submitted a proposal to the Illinois Arts Council for \$10,000 for a project to fund Native American Heritage Month activities and other cultural activities. The project will involve role model speakers in various activities. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003.

**CONTINUATION GRANTS****Adult Education Program (PD# 020402)**

This program provides instruction and services for *Adult Basic Education* and *English as a Second Language* at all seven campuses. The application, for \$20,000,000, is being submitted to the Illinois Community College Board by the District Office (current year funding is \$12,948,513.) The period of performance for the requested funding is from July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003.

**H-1B Technical Skills Training Program (PD# 020403)**

The District Office has received funding of \$500,000 from the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development (MOWD) to provide technical training in skills related to the H-1B-certified IT occupations as described by the US Department of Labor. Participating businesses will determine their training needs and select appropriate incumbent workers for training. Training will be provided at the business location when possible. The original period of performance for the project, from February 1, 2001 through March 27, 2002, has been extended to continue through March 27, 2003.

**Rail Road Conductor Training(PD# 020404)**

Richard J. Daley College has received a grant of \$260,700 from the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development, to provide pre-employment training to Chicago residents wanting careers in railroading. Successful completers will be interviewed for jobs with CSX RR. Historically, 97% of completers have been hired. The project's original period of performance was from April 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001 was extended previously to run through February 28, 2002. Pursuant to section 4.02 of the agreement, "Contract Extension Option" the agreement has been extended, again, to the period from February 28, 2002 to February 28, 2003.

**The Career Transcript System (PD# 020401)**

The City Colleges of Chicago has been awarded a subcontract of a grant from the US Department of Labor to Johns Hopkins University. The subcontract, for \$308,166, is for work to be performed in conjunction with the piloting of the SCANS/2000 Career Transcript System. The original period of performance, November 15, 1999 through December 31, 2001, has been extended to run through March 1, 2002.

**Small Business Technology Resource Center (PD# 020411)**

Daley College has submitted a continuation proposal for \$70,000 to the


Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs to provide quality assistance to high tech small businesses and encourage start-up, growth and development of new small businesses in Illinois. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2002 until June 30, 2003.
