ARTICULATION/DUAL ADMISSIONS AGREEMENT
between
CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO
and
HOWARD UNIVERSITY

REPORTS

that articulation/dual admissions opportunities are available to City Colleges of Chicago students planning to complete their baccalaureate degrees at Howard University. Students who desire to complete a baccalaureate degree at Howard University and who formally request dual admissions may be simultaneously admitted to one of the City Colleges of Chicago and Howard University, upon the approval of both schools; and


that, as part of this Agreement, students will submit applications for admission, along with required documents to both one of the City Colleges of Chicago and Howard University. Students will be notified of admission decisions by each institution; and

that transfer students from CCC must be in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or its equivalent for a stipulated minimum number of credit hours, as agreed upon by both parties.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves the Agreement stating the terms and conditions herein; and authorizes the Chairman to execute said Agreement on behalf of the District.
