RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT BOARD TO UNDERTAKE

ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS REPAIRS AT

DISTRICT OFFICE BUILDING;

DALEY COLLEGE;

DAWSON TECHNICAL INSTITUTE;

LAKEVIEW LEARNING CENTER;

MALCOLM X COLLEGE;

OLIVE-HARVEY COLLEGE;

SOUTH CHICAGO LEARNING CENTER;

TRUMAN COLLEGE;

HAROLD WASHINGTON COLLEGE;

WEST SIDE LEARNING CENTER; and

WRIGHT COLLEGE

WHEREAS, there is a need to repair the building electrical systems 2 at of City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) facilities; and as approved by the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, the CCC District Office staff have undertaken the assessment of electrical systems at most Districtwide facilities; and

WHEREAS, CCC's consulting Engineer of Record (EOR) for this project has completed the assessments at Truman and Harold Washington Colleges and has identified unsafe conditions that require rectification work to eliminate potential life safety hazards to building occupants; and based on cursory reviews, the EOR has determined that life safety hazards are present at facilities yet to be assessed; and that based on the probable costs of repairs needed for Truman and Harold Washington Colleges, the EOR has estimated that the project budget for District-wide electrical system repairs may total over \$10,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the legislature has allocated previously to CCC a \$9,000,000 grant for the installation of a District-wide student information system, but that this project has been undertaken by CCC with moneys from a different funding source; and CCC has determined that funds allocated previously for the student information system should be utilized for District-wide electrical repairs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

CCC is hereby requesting that the Capital Development Board undertakes the necessary building electrical system repairs at District Office Building; Daley College; Dawson Technical

Institute; Lakeview Learning Center; Malcolm X College; Olive-Harvey College; South Chicago Learning Center, Truman College; Harold Washington College; West Side Learning Center and Wright College; and requests that this project be funded by the \$9,000,000 grant allocated previously for the District-wide student information system; and that CCC will provide matching funds for the electrical systems repair project amounting of \$3,000,000.
