KENNEDY-KING COLLEGE**


THE CHANCELLOR

Barlow, Executive Director and implemented through the Kennedy-King College Department of Career Programs, Automotive Technology Division is recognized as a model for excellence throughout the state of Illinois in Workforce Development; and

that the Chicagoland Youth and Adult Training Center (CYATC), reflects the outcome of an effective partnership agreement among: Kennedy-King College, The New City Ministers' Coalition, Ford Motor Company, Illinois Dealer Associations, Metro Chicago Ford and Lincoln Mercury Dealers Associations, Circuit Court of Cook County ~ Juvenile Division, Mayor's Office of Workforce Development, Illinois Department of Human Services, and the U. S. Department of Labor. CYATC provides a life changing experience for at-risk youth and young adults between the ages of 18-30, through automotive technology education and life skills training; and


