that the firm of Mayer, Brown & Platt has provided legislative representation of the District in Springfield during prior fiscal years and their past services have been beneficial to City Colleges of Chicago's interests; and that the firm's partners and associates in Washington, D.C. will be available on an as-needed basis; that the firm has changed its name to Mayer, Brown, Rowe & Maw; and

that Vincent Williams, a principal in the firm of Joyce, Reyes & Williams, LLC was responsible for establishing the City Colleges of Chicago Intergovernmental Affairs office and will be primarily responsible for the services to be provided; that the firm has changed its name to Reyes & Williams; and

that Charles Pizer possesses extensive expertise and knowledge in dealing with federal entities, and also represents the City of Chicago and the Chicago Public Schools and in Washington, D.C.; and

that it is also recommended that the Board retain William Luking to provide lobbyist services for City Colleges of Chicago as Mr. Luking has twenty years of experience as a lobbyist at the state and local level and will represent City Colleges of Chicago in developing legislative strategies and monitoring legislation pertaining to higher education, pension and appropriations; and

- to Reyes, Williams & Associates LLC, 3838 West 111th Street, Chicago, IL, at a monthly fee of \$5,500.00 plus out-of-pocket expenses not-to-exceed \$700.00 per month effective January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003; and
- to William Luking, 120 North Kinzie, Chicago, IL., at a monthly fee of \$1,500.00 effective January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003; and
- to Charles Pizer, 6437 Lily Dhu Lane, Falls Church, VA. 22044, at a monthly fee of \$6,000.00 plus out-of-pocket expenses not-to exceed \$1,500.00 per month effective January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003.
