- REPORTS that Truman College nursing students gave several hundred flu shots at the Ninth Annual Senior Citizens Health and Government Services fair sponsored November 1 in Mozart Park by Cook County Commissioner Roberto Maldonado; and
- that the flu vaccines were provided free of charge by the American Lung Association; and
- that the Nursing students' participation in the fair, supervised by Assistant Professor Thomas Worms, is one of many such activities designed to give them hands-on experience; and
- that the Truman College Nursing Program is the oldest associate-degree nursing program in Illinois, graduating more than 2,000 students since its founding in 1964; and
- that the 2002 graduates had a 100 percent pass rate on the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) for Registered Nursing.
