COLLEGE POSTS SIGNIFICANT ENROLLMENT GAINS  
TRUMAN COLLEGE

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS that as of January 19, 2002, enrollment for the Spring 2002 semester was 4,229, a 12.5 percent increase in unduplicated headcount over Spring 2001, and 2,576 FTE, a 13.7 percent increase over last year in FTE (full-time equivalent); and

that class size has grown as well with sections 96.5 percent filled and an average class size of 27.84; and

that the gains were attributed to strong programs and convenient, well planned class schedules, intrusive advising to encourage more students to register early and outreach and bridge programs, which brought in 963 students new to credit, most of them from Adult Education, and 444 students new to City Colleges of Chicago; and

that Adult Education enrollment as of January 19, 2002, was 10,255, a 6.9 percent increase, and an FTE of 3,023, a 6.5 percent increase over Spring 2001.
