NEW GRANTS

Minorities in Media - Technology Partnership (PD# 02001)

Kennedy-King College is participating in a partnership project along with Chicago State University and the Chicago Public Schools, which has received a grant for \$150,000. The Higher Education Cooperation Act (HECA) grant (received by Chicago State University) will be utilized to upgrade the Bowen High School radio station and the digital audio systems for WKKC-FM.. The performance period for this project is from August 21, 2001 through August 31, 2002.

NASA-Based Modular Chemistry: Curriculum Reform at Harold Washington College (PD# 02002)

Harold Washington College has submitted a proposal to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) for a grant of \$180,000 to develop three modular teaching units for its year long General Chemistry/Lab curriculum. Each module will allow students to gain an appreciation of how NASA-related research impacts their lives. The performance period for this project is from January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2004 with respective funding each year of \$55,000, \$60,000, and \$65,000.

CONTINUATION GRANTS

Chicago Consortium for Higher Education (PD#02003)

The District Office has received funding of \$102,000 per year for a three year period from the Illinois Board of Higher Education for the administrative costs of the Chicago Consortium for Higher Education. CCHE serves as one of Illinois' regional higher education consortia, has been in existence since 1993 and provides services for its higher education members in the Chicago


