
REPORTS that Mary Beth Guinan, Technology Coordinator for the Adult Education Department, Dr. Michael Schoop, Dean of Instruction, and Joy Walker, Assistant Dean of Instructional Technology, have won a \$30,000 grant from Illinois Community College Online, a program sponsored by the Illinois Community College Board; and

that the funds will be used to develop three proven Truman College programs as "rapid response options" to provide English as a Second Language and Literacy programs statewide; and

that the three programs are Instant English, an icon-based ESL and literacy teaching system developed by Ms. Guinan that is geared toward non-readers, the "e-classroom," a mobile interactive learning environment, and the Teacher Development Practicum, which provides continuing education for adult educators and is a hands-on way to create the next generation of technologically literate teachers while achieving maximum results from minimum budgets.
