THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that in 1987, Board Report No. 12775 stated that Washington Academic Scholarships were established to be awarded based on merit to high school graduates registered with City Colleges of Chicago; and

that in Board Report No. 13464 Washington Academic Scholarship guidelines were modified to allow the awarding of the Washington Scholarships to a broader range of students in order to recognize, encourage, and support their pursuit of Associate degrees, skills programs and certificates; and

that Washington scholarships have been utilized to provide financial assistance to students who provide services to the Colleges via Student Government, athletics, college ambassadors, etc., or are enrolled in the Chicago Police and Firefighters Training program requiring a 2.0 GPA; and

that the need to establish two separate awards for City Colleges of Chicago students has arisen to delineate Washington Scholarships based on academic achievement of a 3.0 GPA or higher, vs recognition of students where 2.0 GPA is acceptable.


RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees establish a Washington Grant Program, separate from the Washington Scholarships, to offer financial awards to students with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA and be awarded to cover students' educational costs.
