REPORTS

that in Board Report #22640 dated June 7, 2001, the Board of Trustees awarded contracts to PSI Systems, Inc. for professional consulting services to provide OIT consulting services for the period of July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002 with a one year option period; and

that there is a continued need to retain the services of a professional technology consultant to provide OIT consulting services for the next fiscal year; and

that these services will include the following: Support the Student Administrative System (SPAS), Provide interface system support to the PeopleSoft HR and FMS Systems, change programs to accommodate FY2002 ICCB changes, make required programming changes for FY2003 Financial Aid, including Pell, SEOG, ISAC and IVS, develop Hope Scholarship Processing, CCC policy requirements, develop Adult Education processing for FY2003 requirements for ICCB new processing, develop Workforce Investment Act and Clearinghouse processing for transfer students interfaces, modification to SPAS for: PeopleSoft Human Resource and Financial Systems, IAI General Education courses, and the Student Services Center (One Stop), C Grade Policy, Modification to SPAS due to changes in Federal/State regulations and City Colleges of Chicago academic policy, Ongoing SPAS training, and any additional changes required by the City Colleges of Chicago; and

that PSI 's fees for these services will be in an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000.00 annually, including expenses .

THE CHANCELLOR


RECOMMENDS
