USED SIMULATOR FOR TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING PROGRAM

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that there is a need for an emergency purchase of used simulation equipment for the truck driver training program at Olive-Harvey College; this equipment is needed to provide training to approximately 60 students who are currently on the waiting list for the program, and an additional 30-60 new students in connection with a MOWD grant; the current program capacity is only for 50 students; and

that staff recommends approval for the purchase of a used truck transmission training simulator which meets the needs of the program and is available from GE Capital I-Sim, Salt Lake City, UT for a total cost of \$33,000; this emergency purchase will allow the program to begin training for students on the waiting list immediately; and

that this purchase of used equipment is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

THE CHANCELLOR


RECOMMENDS
