DUAL ADMISSIONS AGREEMENT
with
ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that students who meet the admissions requirements for Alcorn State University and who formally request dual admissions will be simultaneously admitted to one of the City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Alcorn State University (ASU); and

that, as part of this Agreement, students will submit applications for admission, along with required documents to both one of the City Colleges of Chicago and Alcorn State University. The student's City College of choice will notify Alcorn State of acceptance or denial of the student's application; and


that a designated ASU admissions representative will work with City College counselors and students to facilitate the initial process; and

that a student will have junior standing at ASU upon completion of the A.A. or A.S. degree with an overall cumulative GPA of 2.0 in approved programs at City Colleges of Chicago and will have met ASU's general education core requirements.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approve the Agreement with Alcorn State University stating the terms and conditions herein; and authorizes the Chairman to execute said Agreement on behalf of the Board.

DUAL ADMISSIONS AGREEMENT

between

CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO

and

ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY

Students who meet the admissions requirements for Alcorn State University and who formally request dual admissions will be simultaneously admitted to one of the City Colleges of Chicago and Alcorn State University. Dual admissions are available to City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) students planning to complete their baccalaureate degrees at Alcorn State University (ASU).

Students will submit applications for admission, along with required documents, to both one of the City Colleges of Chicago and Alcorn State University. Each institution will separately review the applications and required academic credentials. Students will be notified of admission decisions by each institution. The City College of choice will notify ASU of acceptance or denial of student applications. Students will be subject to the admissions requirements of the Alcorn State University's department(s) and programs(s) in which they choose to major or minor. Specific admissions requirements for ASU departments and programs will be provided to CCC students in the dual admissions program. Currently enrolled students at CCC may be eligible for dual admissions. Admission to Alcorn State University does not guarantee admission to a specific program.

A designated Alcorn State University admissions representative will work with City Colleges of Chicago college advisors and students to facilitate the initial process which includes the linkage with the Alcorn State University department of the student's intended major and the transition from the City Colleges of Chicago to Alcorn State University. The designated Alcorn State University representative will facilitate early financial aid planning, including consideration for scholarship opportunities for which the student may apply and be eligible.

Academic program requirements for dual admissions will be governed by the Alcorn State University and the City College of choice undergraduate catalogs in effect at the time of admission to the dual admissions program. Students admitted under the Dual Admissions Agreement are required to maintain continuous full-time or part-time enrollment. A student will have junior standing at Alcorn State University upon completion of the A.A. or A.S. degree in approved programs at CCC and will have met ASU's general education core requirements. Specific programs will have additional requirements that may be satisfied either at CCC or ASU.

Students remain eligible for the dual admissions program as long as satisfactory progress (cumulative 2.0 GPA) is maintained at CCC. Since specific ASU programs, such as Elementary Education and Early Childhood Education, require a 2.5 GPA for admission, CCC students are encouraged to maintain a 2.5 GPA. They must maintain a minimum "C" average in all general

education core courses, and must receive a grade of "C" or better in all professional courses. Upon enrollment at ASU, good academic standing (cumulative 2.0 GPA) will also be required. The student should be able to complete the baccalaureate degree within the minimum number of terms required for the chosen major, providing the prescribed program has been followed.

A general information brochure describing the admissions process, policies, procedure, and any other relevant information will be developed jointly by Alcorn State University and City Colleges of Chicago.

This agreement will commence when signed and continue until canceled, with at least one-year notice, by either party, or until canceled by mutual agreement. In the event of cancellation, no additional students will be jointly admitted. Any students already jointly admitted will continue with the privileges specified under this agreement as they continue to make academic progress toward the baccalaureate degree, maintaining academic standards as provided in this agreement.
