REPORTS

that in Board Report 22646, dated June 7, 2001 the Board approved an extension through April 30, 2002 of the agreements to operate the bookstores and process student book vouchers at Daley, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Olive-Harvey, Wright Colleges and the West Side Technical Institute of Daley College, as well as agreements to process student book vouchers for Truman and Harold Washington College; and

that during May 2002 staff will issue a Request for Proposals for a 5-year agreement to operate bookstores, provide student book voucher services at each college and include virtual on-line bookstore services; to allow time to complete that process, review and evaluate proposals and prepare final recommendations, staff recommends acceptance of an extension of current bookstore operations through March 31, 2003 to provide uninterrupted services through the Fall, 2002 and Spring, 2003 semesters.

RECOMMENDS


that the Board of Trustees approves an extension of the agreement with C&W Books Inc., Chicago, to operate the bookstores and process student book vouchers at Daley, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Olive-Harvey Colleges, and the West Side Technical Institute from May 2, 2002 through March 31, 2003; and

that the Board of Trustees approves an extension of the agreement with Follett College Book Stores, Elmhurst, to operate the bookstore and process student book vouchers at Wright College from May 2, 2002 through March 31, 2003; and

that the Board of Trustees approves an extension of the agreement with Becks Bookstore, Chicago to process student book vouchers at Truman and Washington Colleges from May 2, 2002 through March 31, 2003 and

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to execute any documents pertaining to the above agreements on behalf of the Board.
