
Wright College has installed four defibrillators at its North Campus, Montrose and Narragansett avenues, to protect those people enrolled or employed at the college and the general public who use the building for other purposes.


The defibrillators will be used in case someone suffers cardiac arrest.

The defibrillators have been installed in strategic locations throughout the campus -- in the parking garage, at the security desk, on the second floor and in the women's locker room in the lower level pool area.

The college's Allied Health Careers division trained approximately 45 personnel to use defibrillators.

Trainees included about 30 security officers, three engineers, six administrators and several support personnel. Trainees will receive repeat training every six months to keep their skills current.
