that the Board of trustees be informed that the *Distance Learning Academy (DLA) of Harold Washington College for Distance Learning* offers a series of professional development training courses for faculty, administrators and staff. Two of these courses are delivered on-line and are taught by CDL Administration. The courses are focused specifically on distance learning technologies and their application within the City Colleges of Chicago on-line learning environment. Others are taught through the Illinois On-Line Network at the University of Illinois – a national leader seeking to promote the effective use of networked information technologies, to enhance traditional classroom instruction, and to build the foundation for supporting on-line education throughout the world, and;

that as of July 2003, ninety-two (92) CCC faculty have taken and completed *CDL 100 INS: CDL Policies and Procedures*, the first course in the *Distance Learning Academy*, series. Seventeen (17) CCC faculty have completed *CDL 201: Introduction to CDL's Use of Blackboard*, the second course in the DLA series, and;

that twenty-four (24) CCC faculty have completed *On-Line Learning: An Overview* – the first course in the *Master On-Line Teaching Certification* series available through the Illinois On-Line Network. To earn the certificate, participants must successfully complete four core courses, an elective course and a practicum.
