END-OF-TERM ENROLLMENT REPORT: FALL 2002

THE CHANCELLOR


REPORTS that in the Fall 2002 Semester (end-of-term data), unduplicated headcount enrollment in all instructional areas reached 85,358 students, and the Full-Time-Equivalent (FTE) enrollment reached 41,181 FTE students (Tables 1 and 2).

Headcount enrollment in the credit program reached 33,004 students, an increase of 6.6 percent over the previous year. The credit FTE enrollment reached 19,401 FTE students, which represents a 9.0 percent increase over the previous year.


Headcount enrollment in college credit, pre-credit, and vocational skills reached 37,171 students, an increase of 5.4 percent compared to Fall 2001 (Table 1). These programs represent the traditional baccalaureate/transfer, occupational and remedial courses in the district. FTE enrollment reached 21,170 students, an increase of 6.7 percent (Table 2).

Headcount enrollment in the Adult Education program reached 31,027 students (Tables 1 and 3). FTE enrollment reached 17,193 FTE students (Tables 2 and 3).

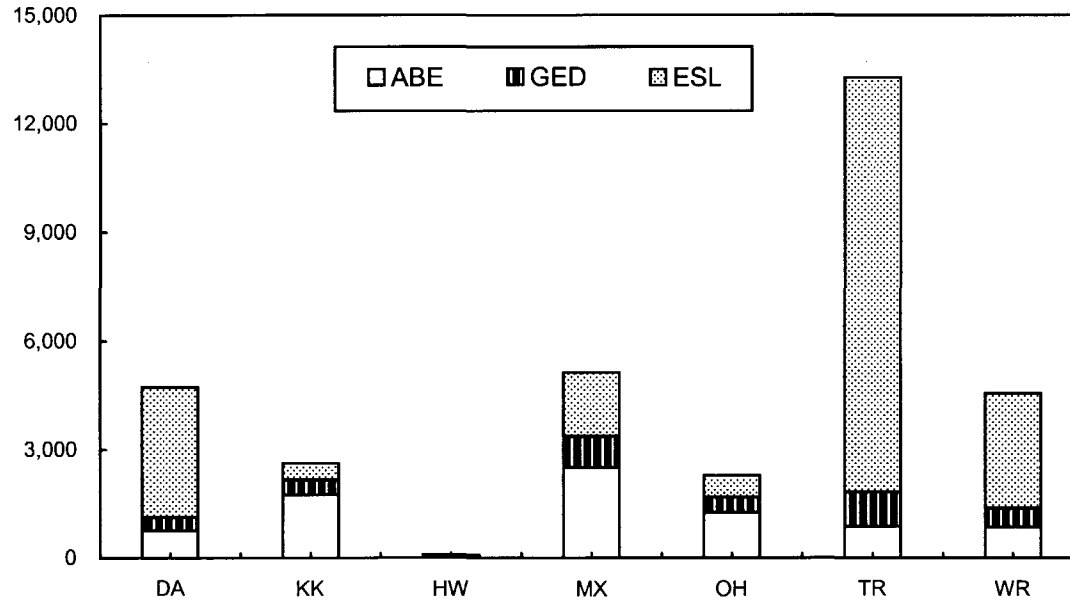
