WYCC Transmitter, Microwave & Antenna Lease
at the John Hancock Center

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that WYCC will be converting its broadcast signal from analog to digital as required by the Federal Communications Commission. The technical plan calls for combined analog/digital transmitters and a dual antenna, capable of transmitting both channels 20 and 21, housed in and on the John Hancock Building. The new transmitter will be housed on the 97th floor, replacing WYCC's old transmitter space on the 94th floor. The new antenna will replace the old antenna on the same aperture atop the building. WYCC will continue to deliver its signal via microwave from Daley College to its receiver at the Hancock center and with digitization will be adding a second microwave antenna to send a signal back to Daley College.


RECOMMENDS
