THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that the Board approved the proposal submitted by Eurest Dining Services (now Chartwells Dining Services), a division of Compass Group, to provide cafeteria and vending food services to the District; and

that staff renegotiated for additional commissions on gross vended sales, support and fundraising, marketing and WYCC sponsorship, product donation and scholarship support as stated in the agreement submitted by Chartwells Dining Services (formerly Eurest) making the following commitments to CCC:

- 1) Provide \$250,000.00 per year or 20% of gross vending sales, whichever is greater.
- 2) Advance marketing funds payable to CCC in the amount of \$50,000.00 (Buildout)
- 3) Operate the cafeterias at its own expense and provide CCC 50% of the profit of cafeteria gross sales less taxes for the District.
- 4) Provide raw and cooked food for the Child Development Program and Dawson's Chef Program at cost.
- 5) Provide ten percent (10%) service fee for catering provided to external clients for events held on CCC campuses.
- 6) Enter into an agreement with Pepsi-Cola General Bottlers, Inc., Chicago to market Pepsi-Cola products exclusively in all District locations resulting in \$583,500.00 in Educational support, marketing, WYCC sponsorship, promotions and product donations.
- 7) Provide CCC \$27,500.00 in educational support fund raising, product donations and scholarships.
- 8) Pepsi-Cola General Bottlers, Inc. dba Pepsi Americas (PAS) shall pay CCC annually beginning 1-1-03, \$25,000 in additional marketing funding, due on or before June 30th of each year.
- 9) Pepsi-Cola General Bottlers, Inc. will donate \$2,000.00 worth of product during each year.

that Chartwells Dining Services (formerly Eurest) is in compliance with the District's M/WBE requirements.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves an agreement with Chartwells Dining Services, a division of Compass Group, 216 W. Diversey, Elmhurst to provide District-wide cafeteria and vending services from January 1, 2003 to May 31, 2006 and authorize the Chairman and the Secretary to execute an agreement on behalf of the Board.
