**PROGRAM AGREEMENT - ASSOCIATE DEGREE IN PASTRY ARTS AND  
CONTINUING EDUCATION CLASSES IN BAKING & PASTRY ARTS**

**THE CHANCELLOR**

**REPORTS:** that the City Colleges of Chicago ("CCC") desires to: (i) offer classes leading to an Associate Degree in Pastry Arts; and (ii) provide continuing education classes in the baking and pastry arts (collectively referred to herein as "Programs"); and

the internationally renowned French Pastry School ("FPS") has operated a baking and pastry arts training program with CCC and desires to continue its affiliation with CCC to design, provide and administer the Programs; and

FPS has developed a 24 week curriculum that will be offered a **minimum** of two and **maximum** of four times per year. The tuition and fees will be \$13,477.00 per student; and

FPS will pay CCC \$1,773.00 per student in the Associates Degree Program and \$105 per student in the continuing education programs. FPS shall be responsible for all costs associated with the program; and

CCC will benefit from association with two world reknowned pastry chefs who will help build and expand our programs and reputation.

**THEREFORE THE CHANCELLOR**

**RECOMMENDS:** that the Board of Trustees authorize the Chairman to negotiate and execute a three year agreement with FPS to provide classes leading to an Associate Degree in Pastry Arts and continuing education classes in the baking and pastry arts.
