REPORTS

that it is necessary to purchase books and instructional materials each year for students in the Adult Learning Skills Program at all Colleges and specialized career programs including: Health Occupation Career Programs, Computerized Numerical Control, Tool Technology and Offset Printing and Food Service Programs at Dawson Technical Institute, Kennedy-King College; and

that bids were not solicited because the books and instructional materials for the Adult Learning Skills Program and Career Programs are considered sole source and are exempt from competitive bidding; and

that exact quantities or costs of purchases cannot be determined because titles and quantities will vary depending upon each Colleges' requirements; and

that based on previous usage, estimated purchases from the following publishers/ distributors may exceed \$10,000 during FY2004:
