NEW GRANTS

One Stop Information System Grant (PD# 030613)

The District Office has received an award of \$2,000,000 for information technology from the Illinois Community College Board. The grant will allow the District to revamp its wiring infrastructure. The performance period for this project is from January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2004.

SBC Mobile Computer Skills Training (PD# 030615)

Wright College has submitted a proposal to the SBC Foundation for \$48,970 grant to fund a project which would establish a mobile computer lab which would be utilized for workforce training and other training in disadvantaged neighborhoods. The performance period for this project is from August 1, 2003 through July 31, 2004.

CONTINUATION GRANTS

National Youth Sports Programs (PD# 030614)

The City Colleges of Chicago has requested funding from the NYSP Fund for Summer, 2003 programs. Federal funds are coordinated through the NCAA and provided for "Youth Education through Sports" programs for children ages 10 to 18 for the period from June through August, 2003. Program requests are being made for:

- Kennedy-King College (\$78,000)
- Daley College (\$74,900)
- Olive-Harvey College (\$83,902)
- Malcolm X College (\$92,500)

The performance period for the funded project is from June 1, 2003 through May 31, 2004.

Illinois State Board of Education Summer Food Services (PD# 030615)


The City Colleges of Chicago has requested funding of \$235,626 from the Illinois State Board of Education to provide food services (lunch and snacks) for participants of Summer, 2003 National Youth Sports Programs and other programs. Food services would be provided during the period from June 1, 2003 through August 30, 2003.
