



that Wright College hosted the Chicago Public Schools Area 1 half-day Young Scientists Science Fair for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders on Friday, January 25, 2003. There were 9 sixth graders, 27 seventh graders, and 70 eighth graders from 52 Chicago Public School elementary schools/academies who participated with projects in Environmental Science, Behavioral Science, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Electronics, Health Science, Microbiology, Zoology, Material Science, Engineering Science, Aero-Space Science, Earth Science, and Computer Science. There were approximately 100 educators and judges who attended. An award ceremony for each grade culminated the Science Fair program. This event was coordinated by the Director of Student Affairs/Activities with extensive support from the Engineering Staff.
