REPORTS

that OIT is developing an Enterprise Management Plan which will define over a three year period, the implementation and updates to the PeopleSoft systems – Student Administration, Financial and Human Resources, the integration between the systems and define the necessary resources for implementation and continuous operational support; and

that the planning process for the infrastructure and security will require the investigation, analysis, evaluation and formulation of information pertaining to the to the infrastructure and security plan components; and

that until the infrastructure and security components of the plan are fully develop there is a need for technical support of the e-directory technology used to access the PeopleSoft Student Administration System and the upgraded version of the PeopleSoft Human Resource System, version 8.x; and

that staff has received a proposal from SDI to provide the required professional consulting services to assist in the formulation of the infrastructure and security components of the plan and provide technical support of e-directory technology for the period of May 12, 2003, through November 11, 2003 with a total cost not to exceed \$275,000.00 which includes expenses and an option to renew; and

that the CCC executive committee has determined that SDI has the required expertise and experience to provide the services required; and

that this professional service agreement is exempt from competitive procurement and that these services are contingent upon budget allocations for FY2004.

THE CHANCELLOR


RECOMMENDS

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
